Moths Reported to Occur in Nebraska as of 31 December 2019

Column A – This is the species checklist # from "Check List of the Lepidoptera of America North of Mexico" 1983. Ronald Hodges et al

Column B – This is the taxonomic Family to which the species belongs. All species belong to Phylum Arthropoda, Class Insecta and Order Lepidoptera

Column C – This is the genus in which the species has been placed.

Column D - this is the species name for the moth listed

Column E – This is the subspecies name for the moth listed or other species names (synonyms) the moth may have been previously named.

Column F – This column contains a link to the Moth Photographers Group's page for the species. There you can find photos, range maps (which include only records submitted to them), taxonomic notes and links to other references.

Column G – This column lists the source of the first record if known. Records from the University of Nebraska State Museum (UNSM) are from a spreadsheet compiled by Dr. M. J. Paulsen in 2019. While first collection dates are not on this listing UNSM is given precedence as first records. Richard Rosche (RCR) compiled a "Partial List of Nebraska Moths" List in 1989 from records sent to him as state/zone coordinator for the Lepidopterists' Society (cover page attached). RCR records are from this listing. Later contributors include MAB (Mark Brogie), Barbara and Loren Padelford (BLP), Neil Dankert (NED), Steve Spomer (SMS), Colin Croft (CDC) and Cynthia Whittier (VDB).

Column H – This column contains BugGuide links to specimens from Nebraska and often the person making the identification. The first record is linked unless there is clearer photo (my judgement). For NED records (not pictured/linked) Ron Leschner (RHL) or Paul Opler (PAO) made species determinations.

Column J – Date of first collection

Column K – Other counties where the species has been found (up to 5)
